Daisy's will earn their Money Counts Badge by:

1. Understand different kinds of coins

- a. Lay out different coins on a table. Search for a penny, nickel, dime, and a quarter. What is the same about them? What is different? Which is the smallest, the largest? What are their colors?
- b. Learn about the value of each coin. How many pennies equal one dime?

2. Know more about paper money

- a. Money can be a coin or paper bill.
 - a. Different coins and bills are worth different amounts of money. Fill in the blank. One dollar is worth __ pennies, __ nickels, __ dimes, and __ quarters?
- b. Each bill is worth a different amount.
 - a. Make your own paper \$1, \$5, \$10, and \$20 bills or print this Girl Scout money (double-sided)

 - b. Find the number on each bill that tells you how much it's worth.

3. Find out the cost of fun

- a. Sometimes the things we might enjoy doing with our families or Girl Scouts cost money! Plan for something you would like that costs money. With your family, pretend you would like to buy something fun like a toy, or a gift for someone else and research how much it costs. If you really want that item, you will need to save that much money!
