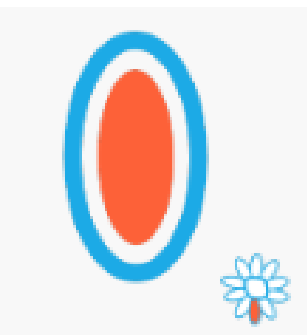
Step 3: Time to write your own story or draw a picture to tell your story
