Badge Overview

Through earning this badge, Brownies will learn how to go on an outdoor trail run or go on 3 different types of hikes.

Badge Components

1. Choose your adventure

Will it be outdoor trail running or will you experience 3 different kinds of hikes?

- o If you choose trail running, you will be working to quicken your pace or walk less during your run?
- O If you choose to roam for 3 types of hikes you can enjoy nature in a multitude of ways like a hike in the rain, urban hike through the town, a night hike looking for stars, or a photo hike where you take pictures as you go.

- First Aid kit supplies

2. Plan and prepare

Now that you know which trail adventure you are going on, its time to get ready

- Think about what you will need for your adventure.
- O What things should you always take hiking with you?
- O Where will you go on your adventure?
- O Will you need a budget to plan for any costs?

3. Grab your gear

Create a hiking pack with your necessities, remember to be prepared for weather, thirst, hunger, and an accidental scrape or cut. You will be the one carrying your pack so make sure you don't add in anything that is not necessary.

4. Train for your adventure

Before going on your adventure, you should always stretch and warm-up.

- Another part of training for a hiking adventure is practicing first aid. Ask your guardian to help you learn basic first aid like disinfecting a cut and applying a bandaid or wrapping a sore muscle with a bandage.
