

Daisy Outdoor Art Maker Badge

Pillar: Outdoor and Civic Engagement/Life skills **Outcomes:** Strong sense of self and positive values

Daisies explore the outdoors, and they use what they see and hear to make different kinds of art projects!

- 1. See the colors of nature
 - a. Make art that's inspired by outside. On a nice day, go outside with your family, a blanket, and your art supplies! Create art together with the colors of the outdoors you see.
 - b. Create art with any materials from outside that are safe to bring inside and use! This is a great time to have a discussion about Earth's limited resources, the importance of 'Leave No Trace', and what she can do to help the environment (You can learn more about Leave No Trace at https://lnt.org/).
- 2. Hear the sounds of nature
 - a. Draw a picture of your favorite outdoor sound! If you don't have one, some examples are a bird chirping, tree leaves rustling, kids laughing, or a dog barking.
 - b. Brainstorm and create a list of all the sounds you might hear when you go outside. Cross off all the ones you hear!
- 3. Share your outdoor art
 - a. Share your work on the GSKSMO Virtual Art Showhttps://www.gsksmo.org/en/events/virtual_art_show.html
 - b. Take a photo of your art and send it to your troop leader and family members!

When girls have earned this badge, they'll know how to look at nature like an artist and make their own outdoor art.
