Does anyone remember what observation is?


Answer: Watching and noticing something using all of your senses, especially sight, to get information and better understand a situation or environment.




Create a Field Notebook



Scientists need somewhere to store their observations, so they keep a field notebook. You'll take your notebook with you when you do your citizen science project so you can keep a record of what you see and do.








Animal Tracking Field Notes

Find 3-5 different animal tracks in your yard for 2 days. Don't forget your field notebook! Pay super close attention to all of the details!


