Badge Overview

No matter what you do with your collage, there won't be another just like it in the world. Everything—from the materials you choose to how they are assembled—is up to you. Get ready to see the creative possibility in everyday objects: This badge is an opportunity to make art as unique as you are.

Badge Components

1. Explore collage

Earn this step by first watching this <u>video</u> about the basics of collage. Then watch this quick <u>video</u> to learn about 2 pieces by well-known artists.

2. Focus on composition

Earn this step by creating a cubomania collage!

O Cubomania is a technique where you print an image, cut it into squares like a grid, and then rearrange them. You can rearrange them methodically, or completely at random!

3. Create with color

Earn this step by creating a collage centered around color!

- O Learn more about the color wheel with the graphic on this page.
- O Then create a collage that focuses on one color (monochromatic), or uses complementary or analogous color groups as described in the graphic to create harmony.

4. Use found objects

Earn this step by creating a collage that includes 3-D objects.

O You can get creative by mixing different 2-D and 3-D pieces to create dimension; maybe you even create the collage on a 3-D object that isn't your usual paper or canvas surface!

5. Share a message

Earn this step by creating one final, meaningful collage that brings a message to life.

- O Decide what message you want to convey, and what things you will need to represent it in an artistic way.
- O Consider varying composition, dimension, and color choices as you explored in the previous steps, and bring your vision to life!
- O Then, share your collage with others and see how it speaks to them and makes them feel.
