Badge Overview

Find out how to use design concepts and fix-it tactics to turn a simple space into a creative statement. When you've earned this badge, you'll know how to do a fast, fun, and thrifty room makeover.

Badge Components

1. Gather ideas and inspiration

The Internet is an endless source of ideas and inspiration.

- O Pinterest is a great starting place. Start by searching by color, theme, idea, you name it! Create a Pinterest board of all of your inspiration and possibly some projects you'd like to do for your room.
- O If you don't want to make a Pinterest board, find and print some photos off the Internet and make a collage of your vision for your room.

2. Paint something

With the permission of your parent/guardian, find an object in your room that could be brightened up with some paint. It could be a piece of furniture, your walls, a piece of artwork, anything!

Paint this object and find a spot for it in your room.

3. Sew or glue something

Would a new accent pillow look nice on your bed or chair? Does your room need some new curtains? Maybe a t-shirt quilt?

- O Find something that you can sew for your room to give your room a more personalized feel.
- O If you're not familiar with sewing, ask someone older for help and/or watch this <u>video</u> for some tips on using a sewing machine.

4. Redo something

This is up to you! Maybe your closet needs to be organized or your room can be rearranged.

O Find a way to give your room a refreshed feel.

5. Build something
