Badge Overview

Girl Scouts are always on the lookout for ways to help others and make a difference. But how do you go from identifying a social problem to developing a great solution? This badge will show you how!

With the skills of a social innovator, you'll be able to create Take Action projects for your Leadership Journeys or Gold Award that are useful, informed, and truly change the world!

Before beginning the badge steps, identify an issue you want to focus on. Pick something that is specific and small enough in scope to truly explore, and is something you have a passion for!

Badge Components

1. Explore the big picture

Earn this step by creating an infographic on your chosen issue.

2. Make connections

Is your issue one that crosses borders or do other cultures have a similar issue? How do social innovators there address it?

O Earn this step by exploring your chosen issue on an international scale. Find 2 different cultures that address your issue or something similar and can serve as inspiration!

3. Build empathy for people affected by the issue you've identified

It is important to understand your issue from the perspective of others, especially those who are directly affected by it.

- Earn this step by finding out more about how your chosen issue affects individuals in your community.
- O How does their life differ from yours?

4. Develop a solution from a specific point of view
