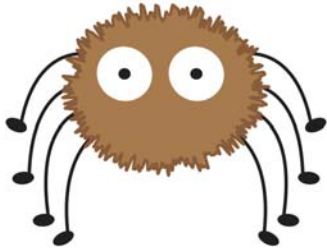


Arachnologist

Paleontologist

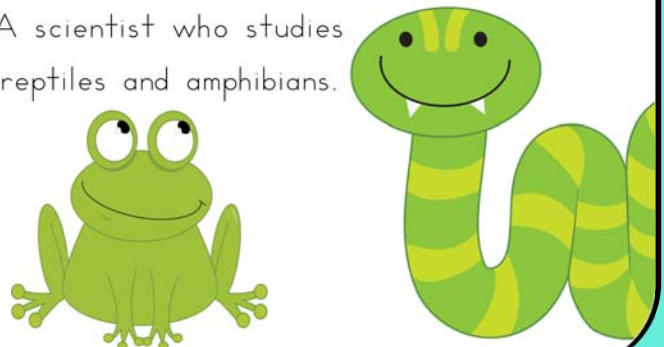


A scientist who studies fossils.

Herpetologist

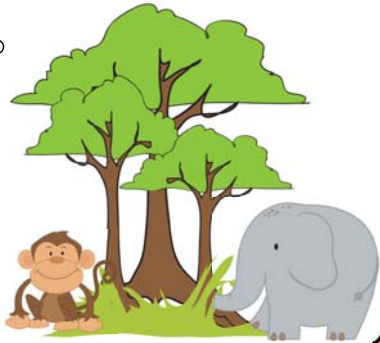
A scientist who studies reptiles and amphibians.

Veterinarian

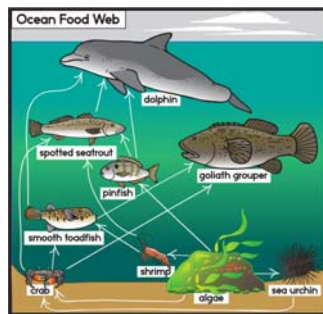
A person who cares for and helps sick or injured animals.

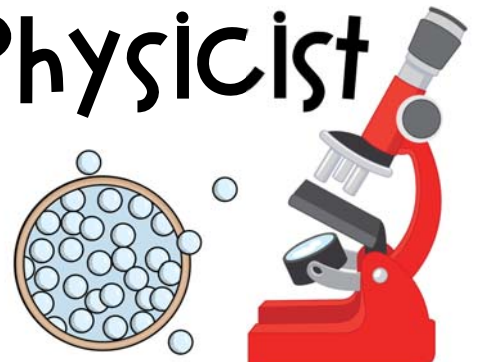
Aviator

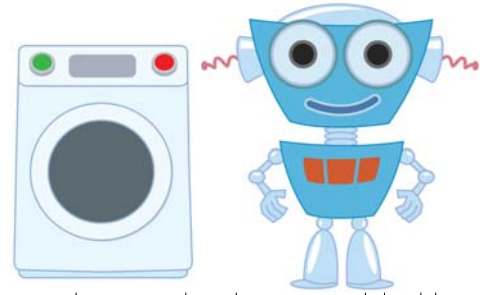
Pedologists

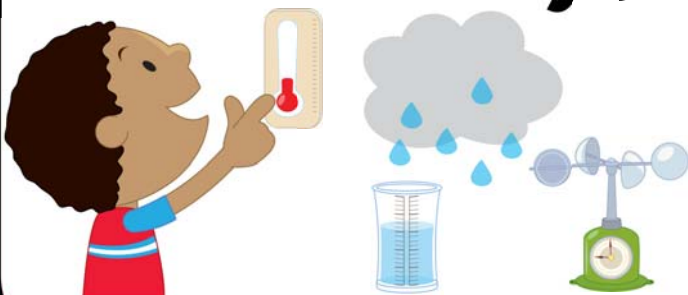
Geologist

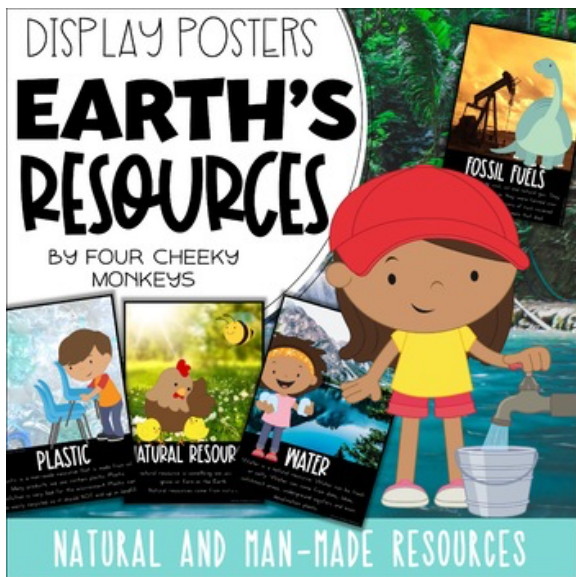
Meteorologist
