These are the badges listed in official guide books.



JOURNEY SUMMIT

LEVEL BRONZE, SILVER, GOLD



GSUSA Journey Summit Pins are earned by completing 3 Journeys.

All levels in GirlGuiding UK can earn Bronze, Silver, and Gold for their level.

- Bronze requires 2 Theme Awards
- Silver requires 4 Theme Awards
- Gold requires all 6 Theme Awards

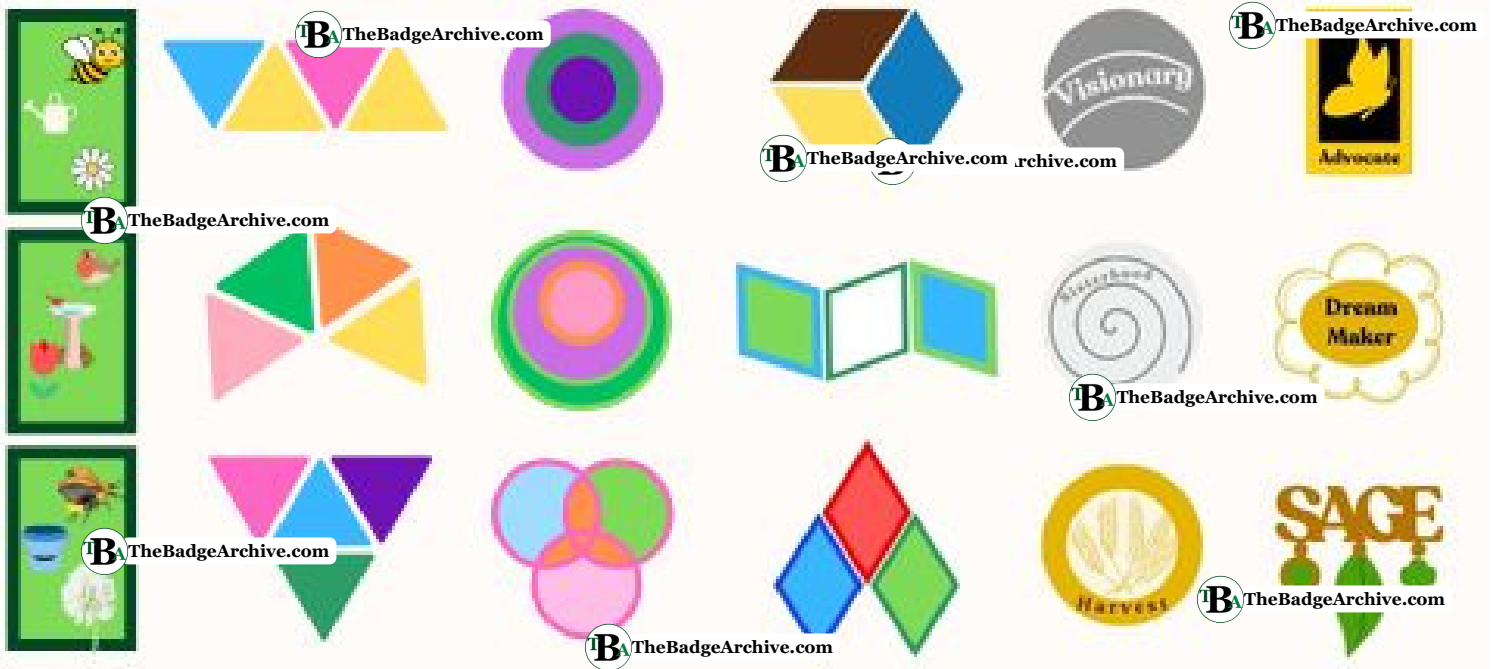
SKILLS BUILDERS

All levels in Girlguiding UK can earn Skills Builders (Staged badges). They are designed with lower stages (one and two) being for the youngest's Girlguide experience in mind. The highest stages (five and six) are designed for the eldest's Girlguide experience. Girlguides may work on lower stages, but not higher than the recommended level.



- Rainbows are recommended to do Stages 1-2
- Brownies are recommended to do Stages 2-3
- Guides are recommended to do Stages 3-5
- Rangers are recommended to do Stages 5-6

JOURNEYS



There are three traditional Journey options for each level. An Outdoor Journey and three "Think Like a..." Journeys are also options. Each level has a choice between 7 journeys.

- Journeys all require specific activities
- All journeys require a Take Action Plan - a Service Project with a permanent aspect.

A Journey is required to do a higher GSUSA award: Bronze, Silver, or Gold.

THEMED AWARDS



GGUK Theme Awards are available for every level, but have slightly different requirements for each level.

All levels will require:

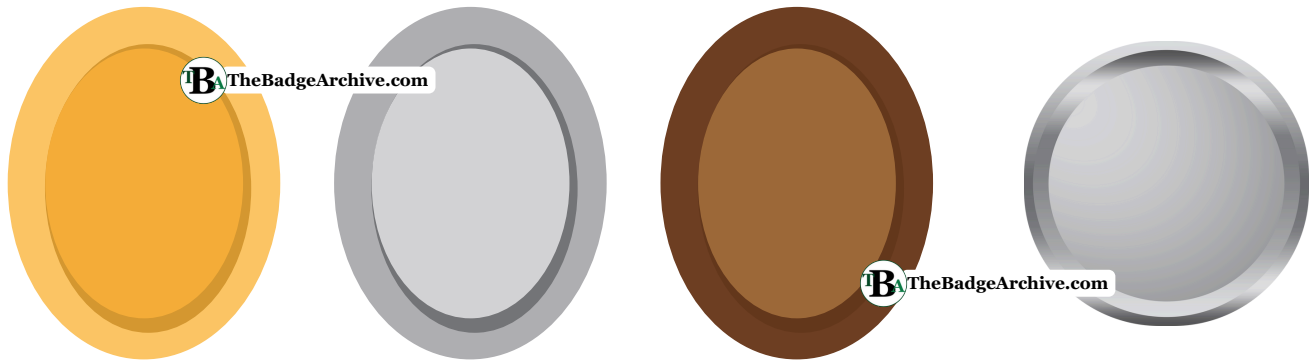
- Choose one of various required Interest Badges
- Choose one of two required Staged badge series (called Skills Builders) and complete one of the six stages.
- Complete a set number of of UMA activities as a troop (cannot be done individually).
 - Rainbows require 2 hours
 - Brownies require 3 hours
 - Guides and Rangers require 4 hours

GSUSA HIGHER AWARDS



GSUSA Gold, Silver, and Bronze are their highest awards. Bronze can be earned by Junior level. Silver by Cadettes. Gold by Senior and Ambassadors. Bronze requires a 20 hour project, Silver a 50 hour project, and Gold 80 hours.

GIRLGUIDING UK HIGHER AWARDS



Gold, Silver, and Bronze Duke of Edinburgh's and the Queen's Guide are Girlguiding UK's highest awards.

Silver and Bronze Duke of Edinburgh's can be earned by Guides or Rangers. Gold Duke of Edinburgh's and the Queen's Guide can be earned by Rangers.

Duke of Edinburgh's requires four areas:

- Volunteering section for 3, 6, or 12 months.
- Physical section for 3, 6, or 12 months.
- Skills section for 3, 6, or 12 months.
- Expedition section for 2, 3, or 4 days

And the Gold requires 5 day residential stay with people you don't know.

Queen's Guide requires five areas:

- Personal development challenge
- Guiding challenge
- Community action challenge
- Lead the way challenge
- Social experience challenge
